

Updated Rules for Mason Dixon Shootout Series races

2017 PNEUMATIC SPRINGS/AIR SPRINGS/AIR SHOCKS BULLETIN (7/13/17)

SPRINGS:

1. ONLY coil springs or leaf springs will be permitted. No pneumatic springs, "air" springs, or "air" shocks permitted.

SHOCKS:

Shock absorbers may not contain any "internal" spring that functions as a load bearing suspension spring, "internal" coil bump spring above or below the working piston, nor "internal" bump stop of any kind.

No pneumatic springs, "air" springs or "air" shocks" permitted.

Only solid material bump stops permitted; rubber, urethane, and plastic. No coil spring or valve spring-type bump springs permitted. No convex disc bump spring permitted.

The only nitrogen charged parts allowed are the shock bodies themselves and must run standard conventional springs on ALL shocks. Stack springs are okay.

These rules will start July 21st, 2017 at Dog Hollow and they will remain.
